

SHL Verify Checking Test (Current Generation)

Assessment Fact Sheet

Overview

Checking is an assessment used for job candidates applying to jobs at lower levels that require checking ability. Sample tasks for jobs that may require this ability include, but are not limited to, verifying data accuracy and locating data entry errors. Potential job titles that use this solution are Administrative support, Data entry, Sales support and Purchasing.

The Checking assessment utilises item response theory (IRT), offering the following benefits:

- Shorter testing administration time
- Ability to offer the test in an unsupervised setting
